

#### Stewardship Spotlight: Catholic Ministry Appeal

We say we trust that God will provide, has a plan for us, will heal us, loves us no matter what, etc. Still, surrendering to God's will and trusting, as St. Francis de Sales reminds us, that he will "...either shield us from suffering or gives us strength to bear it" is easier said than done. Self-reliance, it seems, is more in our nature.

But look what happens when we trust in God's ways. Like Simon Peter's nets that are so full of fish they begin to tear, our life yields incredible fullness when we trust in God. Maybe this fullness doesn't always take the form we want, but it is always what we need. Time and time again, we experience God's boundless love, but fear causes us to revert to the habit of relying on our own efforts. We are afraid to give ourselves over to the Lord even though He repeatedly tells us to "be not afraid."

Even in our own faltering, we can help others experience God's grace – and experience it ourselves. By supporting our Catholic Ministry Appeal, we can bring this feeling of plenty to those who need to know God's love for themselves.


#### Youth Ministry




