

Fasting and Abstinence guidelines during Lent

Fasting: Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday during Lent. Fasting means eating one full meal and two smaller meals that don't add up to a full meal. Snacking between meals is not allowed.

Abstinence: Catholics aged 14 and older are required to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays during Lent.

This weekend, Sacred Heart will host an event known as the Stewardship Fair. In the past, the parish has had something similar to this called the Ministry Fair. Given our emphasis on practicing stewardship of time, talent, and treasure here, the name was changed to reflect that approach. Many of the ministries and groups in the parish will have tables displaying what they do to build up the Kingdom of God here at Sacred Heart, whether that's serving at a Sunday Mass, serving the less fortunate, or fostering fellowship and faith sharing in the community.
